WEEDING AND PLANTING MEETING

1. Weeding

Weeding planned for Wednesday and Thursday, April 12 and 13, and the week of April 17 – 20.
Priority items to pull out are : Dandelions, grass, clover and plantain.

Tape and flags and the old sunflower stalks have to be taken out.

The suggestion was put forward for ongoing weeding to prevent problems in the Fall/Spring.

Parents only for weeding, in order to protect the plants.

2. Volunteers

Request for volunteers - A sheet to be distributed in a general mailing to the school population on April 12, containing a checklist for weeding/planting and the dates.

A separate sheet is to be sent out for May 1, and for the Plant Sale.

3. Perennials

Delivery date has been changed to April 25. The plants are for the front garden, and will be purchased from Shell plant money. We plan for a single delivery, with storage indoors due to vandalism in the past (if possible the janitor's boilerroom where they can be stacked and watered)

Planting times set for April 25 – May 5, with two adult "captains" to take the classroom children out in two's for planting.
