Machinery, Hydra Seeding & Wetland Projects Next Steps

Maggie reviewed discussions she has had with a few owners of home-building companies, in an effort to secure equipment/manpower to excavate the wetland area. Maggie has secured a donation of equipment and manpower from Tony Falkirk (at the request of Christopher of Invidiata Homes) – with two weeks notice; Tony will make his team available!

Marius outlined the various steps involved in moving forward:

- 1. Excavation/shaping of area (excavation by Tony Falkirk Maggie)
- 2. Ground preparation & addition of soil (soil ?)
- 3. Irrigation & water stations (Bethlehem Trenching Maggie; irrigation Karen's contact?)
- 4. Planting (whips ?: trees/bushes funded by Evergreen)
- 5. Woodchip pathways (woodchips Davey Trees)
- 6. Fence (post holes by City Maggie; cedar poles from Milton Co-op Kim; Sheep fencing, gates & U nails Karen)
- 7. Terra seeding (Hornby Terra Seeding & Ontario Seed Company Marius)

Note: Marius will confirm length of fencing required and size of seeding/planting area.

Discussed the need for Student involvement with this area and the importance of protecting the area inside the fences – public awareness is key – perhaps the students could make ribbons/posters to decorate the fence; create of outdoor awareness signage "Please don't walk on the Grass", "No Dogs" signs; plantings...

Agreed, all of us need to explore as many connections we have to secure materials!!
